### INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATES

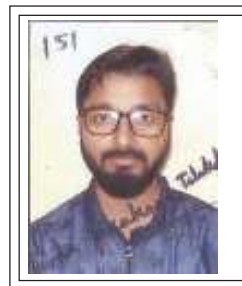
